#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

All participants in the Disney Academic Exchange program take BUAD 261, a unique 15-credit course designed especially for Tompkins Cortland (TC3) Disney students that combines online learning with in-person classes and paid work experience at the world's premiere entertainment company. These experiences, plus independent living in a multicultural environment, provide a holistic and immersive experiential learning program. Active assignments, guided reflection, and critical analysis enable students to develop their knowledge, skills, and values in three interrelated aspects of life as shown below:
